
Dear All Engineering Students,

On behalf of the American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) Hong Kong Student Section, I would like to invite you to join our upcoming event - Virtual Technical Tour to CLP Power Hong Kong Black Point Power Station.



CLP Power Hong Kong Limited. is an electricity company in Hong Kong. It operates a vertically integrated power supply business in Hong Kong, covering electricity generation, transmission and distribution, and customer service. It serves 6 million people in a supply area that includes Kowloon, New Territories and most of the outlying islands. It also has businesses in a number of Asian markets as well as EnergyAustralia in Australia.

The Black Point Power Station is one of the world's largest gas-fired combined-cycle power stations. In support of the Government's plans for significant carbon intensity reduction by increasing the percentage of local gas-fired generation to around 50% of the total fuel mix in 2020, CLP Power commissioned an additional gas-fired generation unit with an advanced design at the Power Station. The new 550 MW unit serves as an expansion of the Black Point Power Station's overall generation capacity and would feature a Combined Cycle Gas Turbine (CCGT) configuration which can achieve an efficiency of around 60%, higher than that of the existing gas-fired units.
